The Winter Shelter Program -The Department of Health and Human Services – Social Services 2016-2017 Winter Shelter Program for families is designed to provide short-term lodging in local motels for homeless families throughout Humboldt County.

NEW FOR 2016!

- Applicants with sustainable income may be eligible for a one-time grant to help with permanent move-in housing costs or financial help to avoid imminent eviction. For those eligible this one-time grant will be provided instead of the customary six week motel stay.
- Applicants who are CalWORKs eligible or CalWORKs recipients will only be eligible for the Winter Shelter Program if they are not eligible to services from CalWORKs shelter programs.

Initial screening interviews will begin Wednesday, November 9, 2016.

- Screening interviews will continue on a walk-in basis for the duration of the Winter Shelter Program Monday through Friday between the hours of **9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. daily** (excluding county holidays).
