



## **2016-2017 WINTER SHELTER PROGRAM ANNOUNCEMENT**

**The Winter Shelter Program** -The Department of Health and Human Services – Social Services 2016-2017 Winter Shelter Program for families is designed to provide short-term lodging in local motels for homeless families throughout Humboldt County.

### **NEW FOR 2016!**

- Applicants with sustainable income may be eligible for a one-time grant to help with permanent move-in housing costs or financial help to avoid imminent eviction. For those eligible this one-time grant will be provided instead of the customary six week motel stay.
- Applicants who are CalWORKs eligible or CalWORKs recipients will only be eligible for the Winter Shelter Program if they are not eligible to services from CalWORKs shelter programs.

**Initial screening interviews will begin Wednesday, November 9, 2016.**

- Screening interviews will continue on a walk-in basis for the duration of the Winter Shelter Program Monday through Friday between the hours of **9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. daily** (excluding county holidays).
